

OMEOWNERS CONTINUE TO DEMAND MORE



According to a survey released by the American Society of Landscape Architects, kitchen spaces ranked as the second most popular outdoor design trend among industry professionals in 2014. It's anticipated that 2015 will prove to harbor increased demand for outdoor kitchens as well.

their outdoor space as having the same luxuries as their interiors, including vignettes designed for entertaining."

Nestled in Avon, Conn., this stunning backyard oasis consists of two levels and highlights multiple cooking and

grilling stations. The upper level features Brown Jordan Outdoor Kitchens' cabinetry, along with a stone grill island and sprawling granite countertops providing ample space for caterers to prepare lavish spreads. The cabinets, made from all stainless steel, feature a bead board door style, powder coated with Brown Jordan's exclusive Java II color, and completed with hardware handcrafted from solid bronze. Also included is a refrigerator that can house beverages and wines.

On the lower level is a woodburning pizza oven station that also features Brown Jordan Outdoor Kitchens' cabinetry and a custom hibachi griddle area. Much like the full-fledged kitchen on the second story, these grilling areas are set in stone, completing a cohesive outdoor living area made for festivities.

"By dividing the cooking and grilling stations as well as the living areas, our team essentially replicated an indoor floor plan for the outdoors," Gotowala said. "Our team superseded the client's desires well beyond the anticipated exterior living spaces to coincide with their luxurious lifestyle."
